# Yolo County Sheriff Aerosquadron Uniform Specification

## Flight Suit

- May be worn in summer/winter
- Flight Suit, Black
- Yolo Sheriff Dept Patch on left left sleeve. (From uniform store) (see Figure 1)
- Aerosquadron Patch on right arm sleeve The squadron patch will be provided by the squadron to member (first two are free, more will be provided at \$5 fee) (see Figure 2)
- Name Tag embroidered First Initial, Last Name i.e J. Doe on right breast in gold lettering
- Wings, hardware placed on right breast, centerd and above Name. Wings may be embroidered in lieu of hardware on Flight Suit ONLY.
- **Badge**, worn on left breast opposite of name. Badge may be embroidered in lieu of hardware on Flight Suit ONLY.
- Sheriff Back Patch size 11x4 (or closest size that will fit) with words SHERIFF in gold lettering
- **Shoes** blacks shoes/boots

#### Summer Uniform

Summer uniforms are worn during Daylight Savings Time.

- Shirt BDU Shirt Black, Short Sleeve. Must be tucked in at all times.
- Yolo Sheriff Dept Patch on left left sleeve. . (From uniform store) (see Figure 1)
- Aerosquadron Patch on right arm sleeve. The squadron patch will be provided by the squadron to member (first two are free, more will be provided at \$5 fee) (see Figure 2)
- Name Tag embroidered First Initial, Last Name i.e J. Doe on right breast. A gold name plate with First Initial, Last Name may be worn instead of embroiderd name
- Wings, hardware placed on right breast, centerd and above Name.
- **Badge**, worn on left breast opposite of name.
- **Belt** Basket weave with gold belt buckle
- **Pants** Black Class-B pants, BDU shorts are optional.
- Socks black
- **Shoes** blacks shoes/boots.

#### Winter Uniform

Winter uniforms are worn during Daylight Standard Time and is the same as Summer Uniform with following exceptions

- **Shirt** BDU Shirt black, long sleeve, tucked in at all times.
- Dickie or Tie w/ gold colored tie clasp
- Shorts may not be worn.

### **Polo Shirts**

Polo shirts are authorized to be worn in lieu of the Class B (BDU) shirt in the aircraft or at meetings. It is not to be worn at public functions, such as airshows. Polo shirts must be worn with accompaning Class B (BDU) pants with basket weave belt (with gold belt buckle).

- **Shirt** Polo shirt black
- To be tucked in at all times.
- Name Tag embroidered First Initial, Last Name i.e J. Doe on right breast in gold lettering
- Wings, embroidered on right breast, centerd and above Name in gold.
- **Badge**, embroidered on left breast opposite of name.
